

Math Policies

Math class meets Monday through Friday. Students are to report to class with the necessary supplies, including homework. Homework is assigned daily to serve as practice and to reinforce the day's lesson. Homework is **not optional** as it is an essential tool for mastery of concepts taught. Homework is to be completed as assigned and may be found on the individual teacher's Sharepoint site. Any missing or late assignments may affect a student's progress.

The trimester interim and progress reports will be based on a variety of both formal and informal assessments which will include tests, quizzes, assignments, and class work/activities. Assessments will be given a point value and may include the following standards: computation, concepts, and problem solving. The trimester grade average will be based on the number of points earned out of the number of points possible for that grading period. Grades are accessible online through PowerSchool.

Any student who is having difficulty is encouraged to speak to the teacher to make arrangements for help.
