

GRADE 4 EXPECTATIONS AND BASIC INFORMATION

1. Three major goals to strive for this year are:
 - Respect for fellow students, teachers, and parents who make up the school community.
 - Development of a sense of responsibility for one's own actions and schoolwork,
 - Development of the skills of listening and following directions in class and all other situations.
2. Students and parents (or guardians) should become familiar with Student-Parent Handbook which contains the behavior and uniform code. This code is the basis for our discipline expectations during the school day.
3. Read and review periodically the homework contract that is glued into the home assignment book. These policies hold for the entire year. Please remember that, in addition to the assignment book, homework is posted daily on our SharePoint sites.
4. Important tests, quiz papers, and folders with written work will be sent home for parent signatures and inspection as soon as possible. This is one method of keeping you as parents aware of your child's ongoing progress or needs throughout the year.
5. If a problem arises, please contact the teacher(s) involved immediately by note, by leaving a message in the office via a phone call, or by email. We are more than willing to help and work with you whenever we can. However, we ask that you not stop by the classroom to discuss problems before school, as we simply don't have the time to give you our fullest attention while the children are in homeroom. We will be happy to arrange a convenient conference time.
