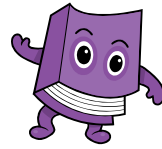


Biography Book Report Directions

Directions This is an oral book report. You may use note cards during your presentation. However, you **should not read word for word** from them.

You should practice a lot at home so that you know what you are going to say well. Your oral book report should include the following:

- facts about the person's early life (where and when he or she was born, family, education, and special interests or hobbies)
- facts about the person's adult life (jobs, marriage, etc.)
- why the person became well-known
- possibly other interesting facts about the person
- The oral report should be at least 2 minutes long but no longer than 5 minutes. You **should** use visuals to make your report more interesting.

You can dress up like your character **and/or** use props, pictures, time line, etc. Please do not spend money on a special costume. Be creative.

If possible have your book with you during your report. ****I will**

collect any note cards or paper just to review your facts. Don't worry if your notes aren't in sentences.
